"It is kind of you to check on us after the storm. Thankfully we are doing well as it passed about 200 miles to the south of us so we barely felt it. However we have enough previous experience to know how devastating this will be for those in Jamaica, Cuba, & Haiti for a long time to come. Many of the farmers in Jamaica have lost their entire crop and the trees may not recover for at least a year. The Methodist Church is responding through All We Can but the situation in Haiti was so dangerous prior to the storm that I am not sure if aid agencies will be able to work there."
