

Trinity Newsletter for 21st January to 1st February

On the 25th January at 10a.m. the service will be arranged and led by the regular evening House Group under the leadership of Rev. Val Spencer. On 1st February we welcome the Rev. Patrick Prigg as our preacher.

January brings us to the Week (Octave) of Prayer for Christian Unity which will follow a similar form to previous years. There will be a daily meeting at various churches around the Town. Each will be from 12.30 and last about an hour. Do bring a packed lunch and drinks will be provided. Wednesday the 21st is at Trinity Methodist Church, after our regular coffee morning. Thursday 22nd is at St. Edmunds RC, Friday 23rd at the URC, Saturday 24th at St.Johns. The gatherings consist of a variety of ways of sharing thoughts, facts, ideas and worship. You are welcome to come to any or all of these on the best day(s) for you.

If you have been sharing with us for a while and would like to know us better, we have copies of an updated Welcome Pack giving details of regular meetings, our ethos and some history. Please ask a church steward for a copy if you would like to know more about us.

If you are a recent visitor to our church it may also help you to know of other helpful things we can offer: the sanctuary is served by a hearing loop. Please turn any hearing aid to the appropriate setting. Hymns and other words are on the screen during worship but hymn books are also available. On the landing of the first floor is a set of pigeon holes which are for anyone to use as a post box when communicating with other members of the congregation or staff. Anyone is welcome to make use of this facility, you can always look as you pass by to see if anyone has left you a note. There may be a rota to pick up if you have volunteered to be a helper in any way - readers, creche and kitchen helpers, stewards and committee members and others may well find a missive for them. The books there are free for you to borrow.

The lift covers the ground, first and second floors, please use it if you need to. The Circuit Office is on the first floor and Yvette, our Circuit Administrator is based there. She also has a dedicated pigeon hole.

A copy of our weekly newsletter is sent out by email if Yvette has your email address and is also in printed form to be picked up outside the sanctuary. Do look out for it and take a copy; you are welcome to take one to share. Details of where to send news for sharing appear at the foot of the document.
